

Award-Winning New “Big House” in Ann Arbor is Open



The newly renovated Michigan Stadium at the University of Michigan was recently recognized with a “Best of the Best” award by Mc-Graw Hill Construction. M-E Engineers completed the engineering and design for the Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing Technology and Life Safety systems for this project.

Michigan Stadium was awarded the top construction project in the sports/recreation category.

M-E would like to congratulate the University of Michigan and project partners Barton Malow Inc. who oversaw the three-year construction, and HNTB, Inc., the architectural designer.

The \$226 million renovation to Michigan Stadium was completed prior to the start of the 2010 season, and the construction added new structures on both sides of the stadium, complete with 81 suites, over 3,000 club seats and a new press facility. Additionally, the project included restroom and concession upgrades throughout the largest venue in college sports.
